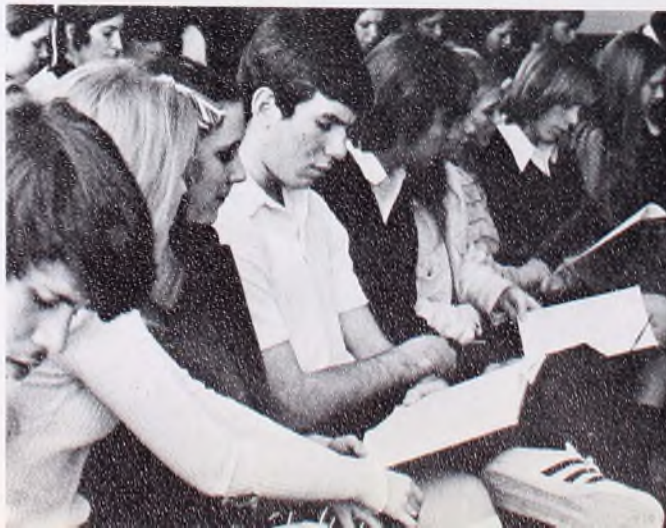

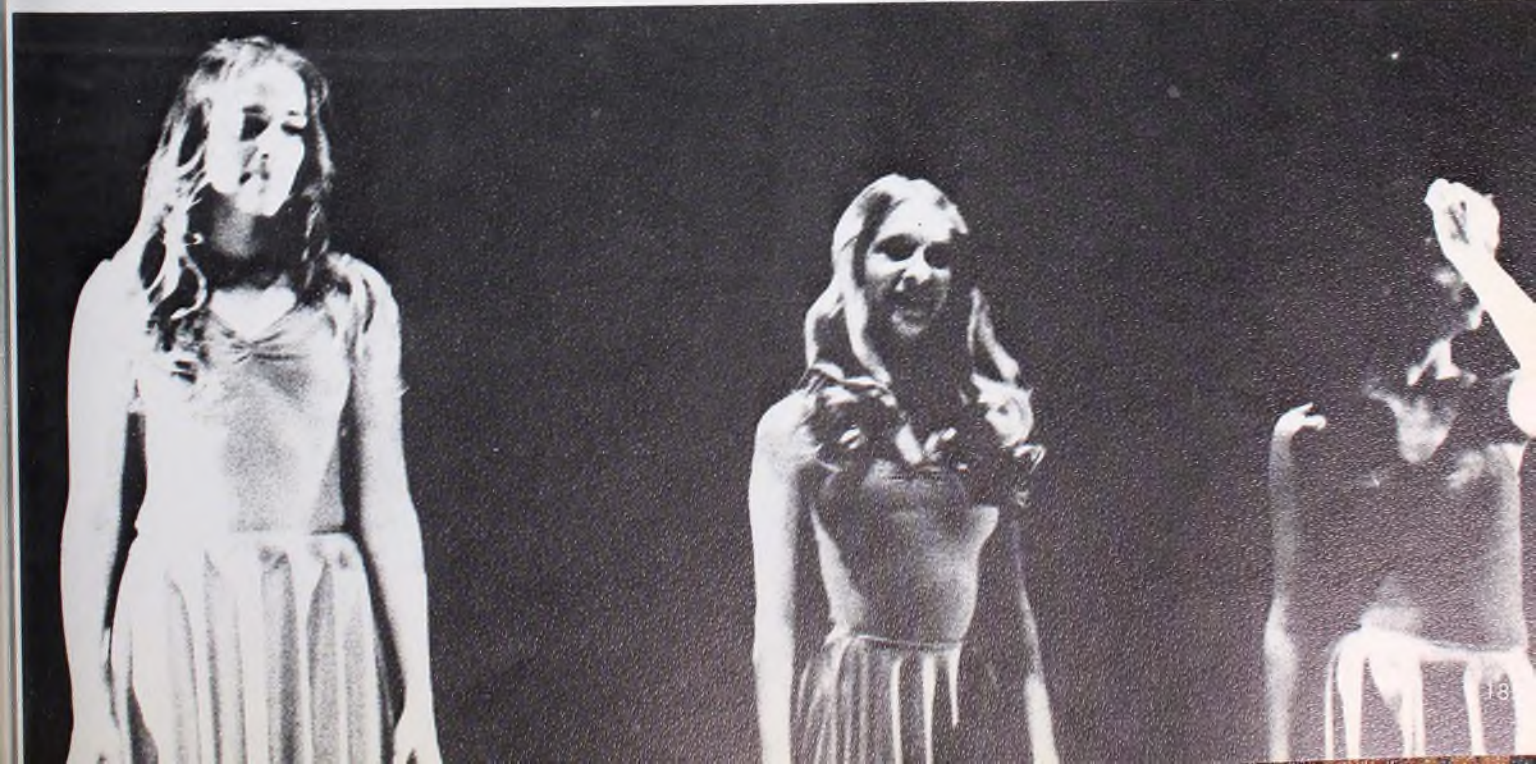




Dance Concert
